This Week's Recipe

Alabama White Sauce

1 cup mayonnaise

1/4 cup apple cider vinegar

1 Tbsp hot chili paste (I use Sambal Oelek or Mezzetta brand from the grocery store)

1 tsp Worcestershire sauce

1/2 tsp celery seeds

1/4 tsp crushed red pepper flakes

1/4 tsp cayenne pepper

Whisk all ingredients.

Add salt and pepper to taste.

Cover and chill. Use on chicken, fish, vegetables, potatoes, tacos....

Can be made 5 days ahead of event
