I hope everyone saw the Rose Bowl Parade, it was amazing!

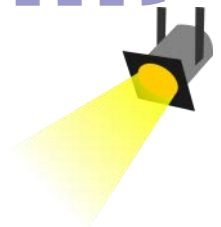
