Recipe for Chorizo and Potato Soup

8-10 oz Chorizo, crumbled into small chunks
12 oz potatoes, peeled and cubed
1 Tbs. Oil
1 medium onion, chopped
1 Tbs. minced garlic
1 tsp. cumin powder
1 tsp. dried thyme
1 bay leaf
3 cups chicken stock
1 cup milk
Salt to taste

Sauté onions in hot oil until soft. Add garlic. Add chorizo, cooking for 5 minutes.

Add potatoes, cook medium heat for 5-7 minutes.

Add cumin and thyme. Taste, season with salt.

Add chicken stock & bay leaf. Cook until potatoes are tender.

Reduce heat, add milk, stir, cover and simmer 10 minutes on low heat. Serve with chopped green onions as a garnish.
